

TIOGA COUNTY'S HAZARDOUS WASTE & ELECTRONICS CONFIRMATION LETTER

BRING THIS LETTER WITH YOU TO THE DESIGNATED COLLECTION DAY

For your safety and convenience, please read the following carefully and sign the affidavit below:

PLEASE NOTE: There is no fee for this service, but you must come on a **designated collection day** between 7:30am-11:30am. The hazardous waste facility is located at the Broome County Landfill at 286 Knapp Rd., Binghamton, NY. Drive to the scale house (the first yellow building) and the attendant will direct you to the Facility. You may have to wait a few minutes before your vehicle can be unloaded, thank you in advance for your patience. **If you are asked to weigh over the main scale, make sure you weigh out!**

WHAT CAN I BRING?

MATERIALS ACCEPTED:

Household Hazardous Waste

- Pesticides, poisons, and fertilizers
- Solvents, cleaners, and degreasers
- Photographic and pool chemicals
- Polishes and floor care products
- Acids and caustics
- Fluorescent bulbs
- Stains and varnishes

Electronics

- Computers, monitors, printers, laptops, keyboards
- Televisions, VCRs, stereos, radios
- Fax machines, copiers, pagers, mobile phones

Up to 3 TV's & 3 monitors per resident

MATERIALS NOT ACCEPTED:

Household Hazardous Waste

- Medical waste (biohazards, red bag or infectious) and radioactive waste
- Asbestos (or containing asbestos)
- Shock sensitive materials (picric acid)
- Explosives or ammunition

Electronics

- Countertop appliances, telephones, answering machines and vacuums
- Large appliances (dryers, dehumidifiers, air conditioners)

Smoke detectors should be wrapped in newspaper, bagged and placed in the trash.

HOW SHOULD THE WASTE BE TRANSPORTED?

1. Bring waste in original or hand-labeled containers with caps and lids fully tightened. Never mix hazardous materials together.
2. Pack waste in sturdy boxes and place newspaper or cardboard between containers to prevent spills. Wrap leaking containers in newspaper and place in a plastic bag.
3. Transport wastes in car trunk or truck bed or as far away as possible from passengers in a well-ventilated vehicle. Secure the load to prevent shifting during transport.
4. Do Not eat, drink, or smoke while packing, transporting or dropping off hazardous waste. Please leave children and pets at home.
5. At the facility, please remain in your car. Trained personnel will unload your vehicle.
