The Public Hearing on Local Introductory No. B of 2016 A Local Law to amend the Rules and Regulations for the Administration of the Tioga County Self-Insurance Plan for Workers' Compensation, which will amend Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1956, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1959, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1963, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1975, as amended by Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1976, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of the Year 1976, as amended by Local Law No. 5 of the Year 1977, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1980, as amended by Local Law No. 6 of the Year 1984, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of the Year 1985, as amended by Local Law No. 3 of the Year 1990, as amended by Local Law No. 2 of the Year 2015 was called to order by the Chair at 1:05 P.M.
