- Rackers Respite Reimbursement
 - Will be combined on 1/1/23
 - Using resource network code to enroll individuals in both programs
- Family Reimbursement Fund
 - Unit pricing to be changed in 2023 once budget is finalized
- Residential vacancies
 - 1 vacancy in the McFadden House in Tioga County
